GOOD NEWS CLUB PROGRAM TRAINING

There are two facets to the Good News Club Program Training:

• Teacher Enrichment and Creative Presentation Resources (CPR)

Teacher Enrichment is designed to train the new workers. This course trains new <u>Bible Teachers</u> who are responsible for presenting the Bible lessons taught during weekly club meetings and <u>Helpers</u> who develop relationships with a small group of children within the club.

Teacher Enrichment training includes:

Session 1: For Team Coordinator, Bible Teacher, Teacher Assistant & Helper

- Help with discipline

Session 2: For Bible Teacher & Teacher Assistant

- Lead songs
- Tell missionary stories
- Teach memory verses
- Session 3: For Bible Teacher
 - Teach Bible lesson
 - Club leader

Leader In Training: For 12-14 years old Good News Clubbers

- Help with attendance
- Help with activities

Creative Presentation Resources (CPR) is an opportunity for the workers to gather together four times a year to review the next curriculum series, receive creative ideas to present a "High Octane" club, encourage one another and pray together.
