

## Golf Talk Growth Activity

Objective: Help saved children to see the importance of pointing people toward God.

Materials: Golf ball, putter and can or bucket

Our speech and actions should guide others to Jesus. Let this golf ball represent a person who needs to get to heaven. The can represents heaven. The object of golf is to hit the ball into the hole using the golf club. If you hit the ball wrong, it does not go into the hole. You keep trying until it gets there.



I am going to try to guide this ball into the bucket. (Try it, if you make it, cheer and if you miss, say “Oops! Guess I’ll try again.”) As Christians, we should be asking God to help us guide people into heaven, and one way we do that is by what we say. If our friends hear us talking about how important it is to admit our sins; believe that Jesus died on the cross to pay the punishment for our sins and to receive Him as Lord and Savior. They’ll be hearing about how to get to heaven, by believing in Jesus only to save us from our sins. But if they hear us using bad words and see us doing wrong things, we’re not guiding them to heaven, and they may not get there. We teach others by our words and actions.
