Introduction: Tell me what you know about kings. What do they do? How are they special?

Presentation: Listen as I sing this song and tell me who is the one true King. (Sing the song with actions for the children) What does it mean that God is the one true King (Ruler over everything, no one higher or more important than Him)

Explanation: Every week at Good News Club we tell you about the one true God. If you know about Him, you will want to tell others about the wonderful things He has done. (Have students name some of these wonderful things they have been learning) What are some of the wonderful things He has done or can do in you? (Save you, help you to not sin etc.)

Application: Saved – the last line of this song tells us that this song is for those who have believed in Jesus as their Savior. How do we know that? (The song says “He is alive in me and you!” Is God alive in everyone? Who is He alive in? (Those who have trusted in Him as their Savior) When you believe in the work He did on the cross, died to take the punishment for your sin and came alive again, God the Holy Spirit comes to live inside of you) You need to “shout it out”, tell others about all that God has done. Invite others to come to Good News Club so they can hear all about God and His wonders.

Unsaved – If you have never believed that Jesus died on the cross for your sins, He does not live in you; He is not your Lord and Savior. Listen today to the Bible lesson so you can find out how He can be your one true King and be alive in you.

Repetition: Have the children sing the song with you using actions. After singing the song several times have the children shout out at the end one thing they could tell others about God.
