

Review Questions for Lesson 1

1. Why was Jon lonely? (*He was staying at his uncle and aunt's farm away from the city and his friends.*)
2. What story did Uncle Jim tell Jon? (*The secret of the watermelon.*)
3. What do the dark seeds remind us of? (*The darkness of sin that separates us from God.*)
4. What does the red part of the watermelon remind us of? (*Jesus gave His blood by dying on the cross.*)
5. Why did Jesus die on the cross? (*He was willing to die because He loves us and wants us to have our sin forgiven and have life forever with Him.*)
6. What happened on the third day after Jesus died? (*He came back to life.*)
7. Where is Jesus now? (*He is alive in Heaven.*)
8. What does the Bible say in Acts 16:31 is the only way to be saved from sin's punishment? (*Believing on the Lord Jesus Christ.*)
9. What choice did Jon make after hearing the secret of the watermelon? (*Trusted the Lord Jesus as His Savior.*)
10. What had happened to Andy? (*He drowned and went to Heaven.*)
11. If you trust the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior, you have a friendship with Him. How can you grow in your friendship with God? (*Read and obey the Bible and pray.*)
12. Who can you tell the secret of the watermelon? (*Answer may vary; review what the secret is.*)

Watermelon Relay

Place a traffic cone for each team along one side of your playing area. Divide into teams and have each team line up an age-appropriate distance from their cone. Give the first child in each line a green balloon (a "watermelon") and a broom. Each child in turn uses the broom to move the balloon around the cone and back to his line. (He may not touch the watermelon with anything but the broom.) He hands the broom to the next person in line and goes to the back of the line. The first team to have everyone move the balloon around the cone is the winning team.
