

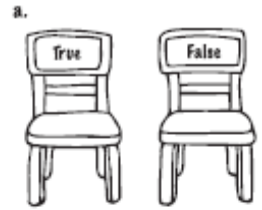
Chair Scramble

Materials

Bibles, paper, markers, large index cards, tape, chairs.

Preparation

Use the review questions for Lesson 1. Label one index card “True” and another “False.” Tape labeled index cards to chairs (sketch a).

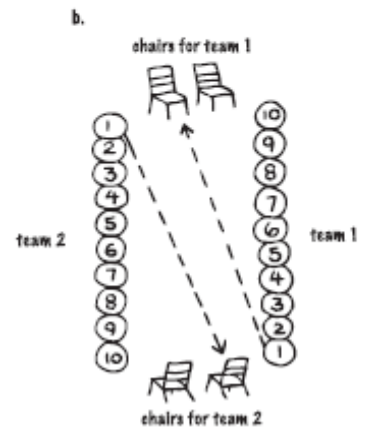


Lead the Game

1. Divide class into two equal teams. (If you have an extra student, he or she may read aloud the true or false statements.)

Teams sit on floor as shown in sketch b.

2. Assign each child a number (sketch b).
3. After teams are seated, leader reads aloud a review question and then calls out a number. The students from each team with that number jump up and run to sit in their team's "true" or "false" chair. The student who sits in the correct chair first scores a point for his or her team. In case of a tie, each team scores a point.
4. Repeat process until all true or false statements have been read. Pause to allow students to correct each false statement.
5. Repeat game as time permits. Ask, "What did you learn about the story?"



True and False Questions for Chair Scramble

1. Last week's memory verse taught us that the grass will last forever. **(False)**
(Truth is: God's Word)
2. God's true Word, the Bible will last forever because God is eternal. **(True)**
3. There is one true God. **(True)**
4. Prayer causes us to be separated from God. **(False)** **(Truth is: our sin.)**
5. The big story in God's Word, the Bible is David and Goliath. **(False)** **(Truth is: How God rescued His people.)**
6. God wanted to rescue because He loves us and wants to bring us close to Himself. **(True)**
7. The people thought the plan for them to be rescued was someone would take charge of their country and sit on their throne. **(True)**
8. The Rescuer in God's plan to rescue us from our sin is Abraham. **(False)**
(Truth is: Jesus)
9. Jesus dying on the cross made it seem like the rescue plan had failed. **(True)**
10. If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior, it is important to spend time with God each day so you can earn your way to heaven. **(False)** **(Truth is: so you can grow to know Him and love Him more.)**
11. You can only talk to God in church. **(False)** **(Truth is: anytime.)**
12. The rescue plan was complete when Jesus came back to life. **(True)**
