

Review Questions to use with Lesson 3

1. Who is the only one who had no beginning? (*God.*)
2. What materials or supplies did God need to create the heaven and the Earth? (*Nothing.*)
3. What was the Earth like before God started creating? (*Empty and dark.*)
4. What did God say His creation was? (*Good.*)
5. When you look at the world around you and see how things work perfectly together (like plants and the clownfish) what does this clearly show you? (*God designed and created it all.*)
6. If you have believed on Jesus as your Savior, what are some ways you can worship Him? (*Sing songs of praise to Him; tell Him how wonderful He is; answers may vary.*)
7. What is one important way man is different from animals? (*Man is created in God's image; man can think, plan and work; man can know and worship God.*)
8. How can you have a relationship with God? (*By trusting the Lord Jesus to forgive your sin.*)
9. Why did God create all the wonders of the universe? (*So people would see them and know and worship God.*)
10. Why were people created? (*To love and worship God.*)
11. Why did God rest on the seventh day? (*Because His work was finished and He was satisfied with it.*)
12. What is our memory verse for today? Can you say it? (*Quote Genesis 1:1.*)

Creation Relay Race

Divide the group into teams of seven or less for this creationist game. Fewer than seven is fine, as some players can go for a second lap, but six is the limit. Gather teams on one side of the field.

- Place one box per team at the finish line. Inside each box, place 1 of each item to represent the first 7 days of creation.

Day 1: flashlights (light)



Day 2: balloon tied to a water bottle (separating the air and seas)



Day 3: potted plants (green growing things)



Day 4: picture of sun, moon and stars



Day 5: plastic baggie with feathers and rubber fish (birds and fish)



Day 6: a stuffed animal or doll (land animals and people)



Day 7: small pillow (rest)

At the word "go," one member from each team runs to the team's box to retrieve an item. Players must retrieve them in order of creation, and then tag the next member to go. If a player brings the wrong item, he has to run it back to the box and try again until he gets the right item. The winning Team is the first to bring back all 7 items in order. Post the attached chart near the box of items.

The Days of Creation

Here's a list of what God created on each of the six days of creation:

Day 1: Light, day and night

Day 2: Sky and ocean

Day 3: Dry land and plants

Day 4: The sun, the moon and the stars

Day 5: Birds and fish

Day 6: Land animals and people

Day 7: God rested
