

## Lesson 4: (Review Questions from Lesson 3)

You will use the questions below to form teams. Ask a question and the child that answers chooses a friend to start forming the first team. Keep asking questions until two equal teams are formed.

1. Why did Jesus suffer in your place? *(Because He loves you.)*
2. Why could the religious leaders not find anything wrong with Jesus? *(He was innocent.)*
3. Why are sins that people can't see still serious? *(God knows about them.)*
4. Why did Jesus remain silent when the leaders falsely accused Him? *(Jesus was trusting God; He knew it was part of God's plan to bring salvation to the world.)*
5. Why did the religious leaders decide to have Jesus killed? *(He said He was God.)*
6. What did Peter tell the three people who asked if he knew Jesus? *(He told them he didn't know Jesus.)*
7. Who did Pilate send Jesus to after he questioned Him? *(Herod.)*
8. Why did Pilate send Jesus away to be crucified? *(The people and religious leaders chose to release Barabbas; Pilate couldn't change the leaders' minds.)*
9. Why was Jesus the only one who could die for sinners? *(He is the only one who is just.)*
10. What does it mean that Jesus is just? *(He always does what is completely right.)*
11. What does it mean to believe in Jesus? *(Trust completely in Him and what He did for you.)*
12. If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior, what can separate you from the love of God? *(Nothing.) through Him might be saved.)*

## Lesson 4 Wheel Barrow Race



Form two teams placing half of each team on opposite ends of the playing area. The first person on each team runs down and tags their teammate and comes back with the teammate being the wheelbarrow. They then tag the teammate in the first line and they run down and do the same thing until on the team members have had a chance to control the wheelbarrow or be the wheelbarrow. The first team done wins. You can play again but have the team members switch roles (the controller becomes the wheelbarrow and the wheelbarrow becomes the controller.)

What was yesterday's Word up? **"Jesus Took My Place"** Jesus died on the cross so you wouldn't have to pay the punishment for your sin. Jesus suffered, was beaten and whipped. He did the hard part just as the person who was the wheelbarrow had it much harder than the person who held their feet and walked behind.
